


Which Wrap is good for you?


Bus wraps are an excellent way to expand your brand and build product awareness. The variety of styles and pricing variables can make your choice tricky to determine which will fit your campaign. Below we have included descriptions of the most common Bus Wrap types along with price ranges to help you choose what will best fit your needs.



Full Wrap

This wrap includes full coverage of both sides, front and rear (no roof)

\$9,500 to \$13,500



King Kong

Includes both sides along with area between front and rear tires, with full Coverage of both sides, front and rear (no roof)


\$4,500 to \$7,500



Full Ribbon

Includes area both sides below the windows and above the belt line.


\$2,800 to \$4,300



Half Wrap

Includes both sides below the windows, half of rear and the front.


\$7,500 to \$11,500



Queen Kong

Includes both sides along with area between front and rear tires with coverage below the wheels.

\$4,000 to \$7,000



Partial Ribbon

Includes area both sides below the windows and above the belt line, between wheel wells.

\$2,500 to \$4,000
